- Complete an initial review of the curriculum against the Curriculum Rubric. The rubric is posted at: <http://www.delawarestars.udel.edu/?s=curriculum>
- If your review results in a successful outcome, confer with your Stars Technical Assistant to submit materials for a formalized approval/
- Submit a copy of the curriculum including all of the accompanying materials – handbook, family companion materials, activity cards, etc. to the Deputy Director of Delaware Stars for review.
- The Deputy Director will forward the materials to the Assessment and Verification Committee for approval. The Task Force meets bi-monthly.
- The Committee will notify the Delaware Stars Deputy Director of their recommendation who will inform the early learning program of the result.
- The information will be added to the approved curriculum list and will be posted on the website.

- Work with the Deputy Director to determine the materials that need to be submitted for Delaware approval.
- They will be forwarded to the Assessment and Verification Committee for review. The Task Force meets bi-monthly.
- Following their review, the Deputy Director will be notified who will notify the publisher of the result.
- If approved, a description of the resource will be added to the approved curriculum list and posted on the website.
